International Graduate Employee Accounting and Legal Assistance Fund DUE: November 1st annually for the <u>prior</u> academic year

GSOC administers a fund for accounting and legal assistance that international graduate employees incur due to their status as international student workers. The fund is \$15,000 for the academic year 2023-2024 and is apportioned based upon the number of eligible applicants and the amounts requested. **Please note: Sprintax and other basic tax application services are not eligible for this fund.** This fund is specifically meant for additional tax preparation expenses incurred due to a student worker's status as such – beyond basic tax preparation that all taxpayers must complete.

The subsidy is available to those graduate student employees who meet **both** eligibility criteria:

- Held a GSOC-UAW Local 2110 bargaining unit position during the academic year Fall 2023 Spring 2024.
- Is an international graduate student at NYU.

To apply, please fill out this form and attach:

- 1. A copy of your appointment letter for one semester of work in a bargaining unit position during the academic year Fall 2023 Spring 2024;
- 2. A copy of a bill for the accounting or legal services you sought during the academic year 2023-2024; and
- 3. The attached affidavit, signed and notarized, proving your international graduate employee status.

Union positions are defined by Article I of our contract and include:

- Graduate students (Master's/Ph.D.) who teach classes or have appointed teaching assistantships or laboratory assistantships (except Ph.D. student adjuncts beyond the 7th year and MBA candidates at Stern)
 - Appointed Ph.D. research assistants (with exceptions at Tandon and GSAS sciences)
 - **Graduate & Course Assistants** (with exceptions at the School of Medicine)
 - Graduate student workers in a range of miscellaneous positions, who are employed by NYU
